

EMBRACING CHANGE to create a vision for the future

The Inter-Parish Collaboration Project is part of the Diocesan-wide Renewal Journey, encouraging each parish to extend beyond its own boundaries and connect with others. This collaboration aims to create hubs where parishes can share their strengths and support one another in areas of need. It fosters a partnership between clergy and laity, emphasising the importance of listening, discussing, and reviewing to cultivate an ongoing renewal journey, all while working together as a Missionary Church.

In September 2024, delegates from the Initial “Pilot Cluster” parishes of Murwillumbah, Tweed Heads and Kingscliff convened, with plans for another meeting in October. They are examining opportunities for collaboration from parish life vitality, financial sustainability and organisational capability perspectives.

Trevor Cooper from Sawtell Parish is leading the Collaboration team, which will be inviting all parishes to participate.


