



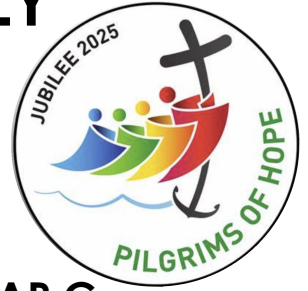

Youth Ministry across the Lismore Diocese is vibrant and growing, and I'm delighted to share some exciting updates with you.

Our Youth Ministry network continues to meet monthly, bringing together parish youth coordinators, Chancery staff, Sr Di, Deacon Anthony Gooley (Director of Vocations), and invited guests. These gatherings are a space for collaboration, sharing ideas, and strengthening the mission of youth ministry across our Diocese.

In a wonderful sign of renewal, members of our Network recently led the inaugural Pentecost Pilgrimages in Port Macquarie and Ballina. Both events were a great success, and we're looking forward to sharing a video recap soon - stay tuned!

Looking ahead, we're preparing to send young people and leaders from our parishes to several major events, including the Ignite Conference (September), the Australian Catholic Youth Festival (December), and YA Camp (December). More information about Ignite and YA Camp will be available soon.

We are also currently advertising for a **Diocesan Youth Ministry Team Leader**. This is a full-time role, based at the Chancery, that will support me in coordinating youth ministry across the Diocese. 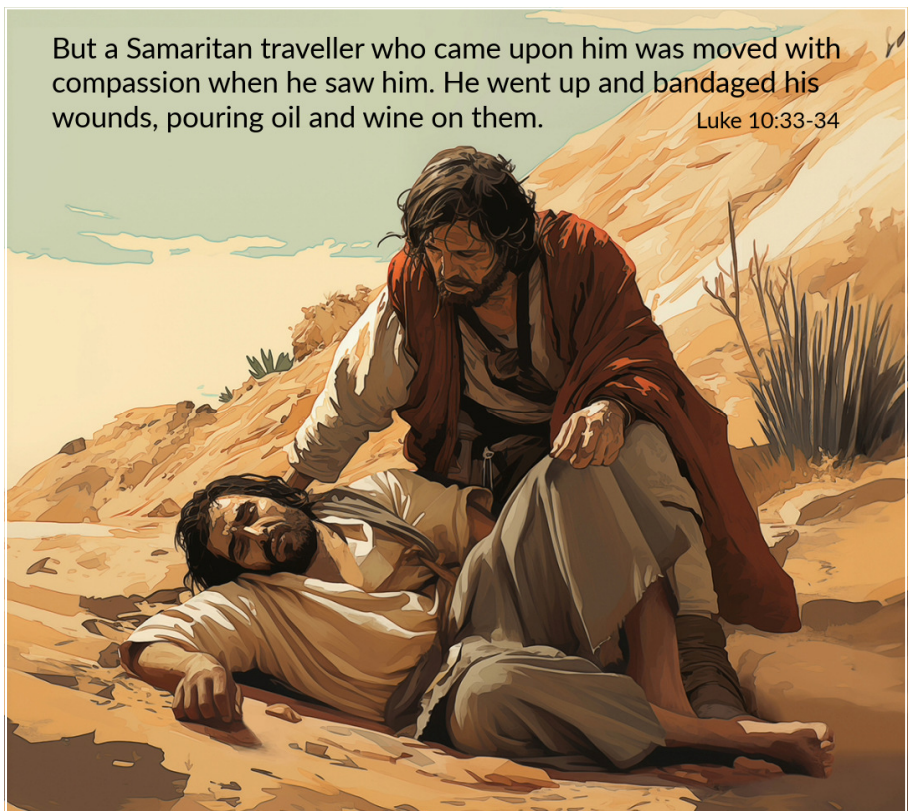
